	<b>Health Evaluation Form:</b> faxed/mailed by medical/mental health provider (except if seen by a medical provider at University Health Services or a counselor in Social Services. If seen in CPS, the provider needs to complete a Health Evaluation Form)
	Personal Statement (optional)
	If you are an International Student: Submit the Medical Reduced Enrollment or Withdrawal Request Form ( <a href="http://internationaloffice.berkeley.edu">http://internationaloffice.berkeley.edu</a> ). You should also talk to an advisor at the Berkeley International Office, 2299 Piedmont Avenue, 510-642-2818 regarding visa/immigration status.

## Other Areas to Consider

- Financial aid (For general concerns, contact Cal Student Central, 120 Sproul Hall, at 510-664-9181. You may also want to speak with a financial aid representative about money that may be owed back)
- Telebears (A withdrawal with a block will cancel all Telebears activity, current and future; you
  will not be able to use it while you are withdrawn)
- Student Health Insurance Coverage (remains active in current semester if paid for).
